

GHPA 2020 show guidelines for exhibitors and their guests:

- Registration and prepayment for all classes **MUST BE DONE ONLINE**. Registration cut-off is midnight the Friday before the show. For example, to show on July 12th, the exhibitor's online registration must be made by midnight July 10th. Registration must be done by each exhibitor or exhibitors' parent/guardian.
- Each exhibitor will provide their own back number. No back number cards will be available at the show.
- No refunds will be given to exhibitors for class scratches and/or inability to attend the show unless a veterinarian's signed note is provided.
- Exhibitor may only have up to 3 individuals from same household and/or their hired trainer/coach.
- Exhibitor and/or exhibitor's parent/guardian must sign a health waiver for themselves and those attending the show at the time of registration.
- All classes will be split to no more than 12 participants in the show ring at any time.
- There will be no high-touch obstacles used for any class.
- The food booth will not be open before, during, or after the show. Please plan accordingly to bring your own food, drinks, and water.
- Disposable masks will be available to those volunteering on the grounds if they need one. Please bring your own masks if you have them.
- Mask use is required for those working and/or volunteering who cannot maintain a 6ft distance from others.
- The judge must wear a mask.
- Sanitation stations will be located at each show ring for general use and hand sanitizers will also be provided at each office.
- 6ft distances must be maintained at each office and around rings to ensure social distancing for those exhibitors needing office assistance.
- 6ft distances must be maintained around rings to ensure social distancing for family members, trainers, coaches on the rail spectating.
- 6ft distances must be maintained at entry gate and warm up areas for exhibitors waiting to compete.
- No tents permitted in the area around the GHPA barn and Small Grandstand warmup area.
- Grandstand and pavilion seating is available for use but you must maintain and follow social distancing guidelines in these areas.
- The use of the Indoor arena (on grounds) is not permitted.
- Use of inside and outside stalls in the GHPA barn will be permitted during the show. It is asked that exhibitors use every other stall if possible to ensure social distancing. Please clean your stall before you leave.
- Trailer parking will be designated to certain areas on the grounds.
- Exhibitors awards i.e. ribbons will be given at the close of the show day for those competing in Jumping, Walk-Trot divisions, and Novice division at one designated area near the Small Grandstand show ring. A check or PayPal payment will be sent to exhibitors receiving monetary awards in the East Show Ring within a few days after the close of the show.
